Holiday Meal Program - Project 150 distributes 5000 full Holiday Meals (2500 during Thanksgiving and 2500 for Christmas) Meal boxes include: 9-12lb Turkey or Ham, 2 cans green beans, 2 cans corn, box of stuffing, jar of gravy, box of mashed potatoes, 2 boxes of mac & cheese and 1 pack of dinner rolls. Boxes are delivered directly to high schools during the holiday week by Project 150 team. Holiday boxes can be printed with partner logo on them - deadline for commitment is May to meet custom printing deadline.

Back to School Program - Project 150 hosts a Back to School Event annually to provide high school students with a new backpack filled with school supplies. The program serves over 500 students during the week long event.

Cap & Gown Program - Project 150 helps graduating high school seniors with financial support to pay for their Cap & Gown to participate in their graduation ceremony. This program serves over 800 students annually.
